- III. <u>Approval of minutes from meeting #3 August 19, 2023</u> Barbara Ringuette moved to approve the minutes from meeting #3 on August 19, 2023. Adriana de la Cruz seconded. MOTION PASSED, with 12 yes, 0 no, and 2 abstentions.

A. Phillip Armstrong requested transparency for the city and for Budget Advocates.

- B. Lionel requested more Budget Advocate engagement in the Northeast Valley
- C. David Kopolev identified an outdated Zoom link on the Budget Advocate calendar.
- D. Kay Hartman announced that Josh Nadel will be resigning from all Neighborhood Council involvement, including the board of Palms Neighborhood Council.

- VI. <u>New Business</u>
  - A. <u>MOTION to authorize the Budget Advocates to spend UP TO \$600 printing flyers for the</u> <u>Congress of Neighborhoods Exhibitor Fair</u>

Motion by Kay Hartman to amend the motion to add "up to", seconded by Adriana de la Cruz. Barbara Ringutte moved to approve the item as amended.

MOTION PASSED, with 15 yes, 0 no, and o abstention

- 2. <u>We table from 10:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. all attendees must register</u>.
  - a) Budget Advocates will be tabling from 10:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- B. DISCUSSION Report on increasing Neighborhood Council Budgets
  - 1. Discussion on how to support Neighborhood Councils requesting a restoration to their former budget amount.

Jennifer Goodie moved to create a template CIS or letter calling for the restoration of Neighborhood Council budgets. Cindy Cleghorn seconded.

- MOTION PASSED with 11 yes, 3 noes, and 1 abstention.
- 2. The Council File for this matter will be 24-0600, which will be available in Fiscal Year 2024-2025.
- 3. Jennifer Goodie will provide a signup at The Congress of Neighborhoods asking people to indicate their interest in restoring funds and to volunteer assistance. She will get back to Kay Hartman and Glenn Bailey regarding the template.
- 4. Glenn Bailey recommended arranging a Zoom conversation with Heath Kline (Woodland Hills Neighborhood Council), who spearheaded the study, to finalize a draft for Budget Advocates to approve before distribution.
- C. Town Hall with Controller Kenneth Mejia
  - 1. The Controller will be asked to present a Town Hall.
  - 2. Further conversations will be had on the idea and an Outreach meeting will be held to flesh out plans. The Town Hall will be available for all Neighborhood Council members to attend.

#### VII. Old Business

- A. <u>Vacancies (Cindy Cleghorn)</u> Seeking Budget Advocates for the following regions One each in regions 1, 4, 7, 10 and 12, and two each in regions 5, 6, 8, and 9. Anyone interested in participating should contact the Co-Chairs or Parliamentarian.
  - 1. Cindy will be sending out additional emails to fill vacancies before the next meeting. She will proceed with elections in regions 1 and 7.
- B. <u>Visiting NCs to make Budget Advocates Reports</u>
  - Budget Advocates are reminded to visit their Neighborhood Councils to provide reports and to hear constituent concerns. Members sharing a region should divide responsibilities, regarding visiting Councils. Please inform Co-chairs who will be covering which Neighborhood Councils, so a contact can be provided to constituents, as needed.

- b) Members are invited to request personalized business cards if desired, keeping in mind that only nine months remain until the end of the term. Kay Hartman will email everyone to let them know of the option.

    - a) She will hear concerns about the financial contributions to the Budget Advocates being denied. Glenn and Kay will arrange in advance to solidify the message to communicate to her. Glenn will start a draft to be shared in the Budget Advocates' account.
