- **Support for City Departments** - Personnel, General Services, Information Technology
- **Liability related** - City Attorney, Police Inspector General, Mayor's office
- **BAs Special Interests** - Aging, Animal Services, Disability, Youth Development, Zoo
- **Neighborhood Council issues** - DONE, City Clerk
- **Proprietary Departments** - Airports, Ports, Water & Power
- **Government** – Mayor, City Council, Chief Legislative Analyst
